Q: What does Social Action mean within the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc?

A: When members and chapters participate in activities that will uplift their communities as related to the Internationally Mandated Programs.

Q: What are the 10 (ten) Internationally Mandated Programs of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc?

A: Achievement Week; College Endowment Fund; Health Initiatives; Memorial Service; **NAACP***; Reclamation and Retention; Scholarship; Talent Hunt; Voter Registration, Education and Mobilization; and Social Action.

Q: What are the standards for judging the Social Action activities by chapters?

A: The International Social Action Recognition Criteria Report dated July 3, 2017 establishes these standards.

A: A copy of the International Social Action Recognition Criteria Report can be obtained from your District's Social Action Chairman.

Q: How are the standards for judging the Social Action activities by chapters **scored**?

A: The International Social Action Criteria Scoring Spreadsheet is used to record and calculate chapter's activities and can be obtained from your District's Social Action Chairman.

Q: Where can I **find** more information about Social Action?

A: Contact your chapter's or district's Social Action Chairman.

Note: (The requirement to purchase a NAACP Life membership by all Chapters is still in place. This requirement will disqualify each chapter for the COTY Competition if not met.)
