 - Could this lead to a lawsuit against me?
- 4. What would my parents, wife, or siblings think?
- 5. Could this post or text cost me my job or scholarship?
- 6. Could this post or text cost me my family?
- 7. Why am I responding to this post or text?
 - Should I dignify this post or text this with a response?
 - What could be the fallout?

GOOD SOCIAL MEDIA CONTENT

Photographs that should be your posted to you chapter social media accounts include:

- 1. Brother's graduations pictures in cap and gown on campus.
- 2. Brother's conducting service projects / mandated programs
 - Mentoring
 - Clothing and food drives
 - Voter registration drives
 - Blood Drives
 - Scholarship presentations
- 3. Brothers attending community events.

BAD SOCIAL MEDIA CONTENT

Don't submit posts, texts, or photos of brothers making inappropriate gestures or brothers wearing inappropriate attire.

- Tattered and torn clothing
- Sagging pants and underwear showing
- Tongues out
- Bare chest, no shirt, or nudity
- Clothing with sexual references
- Aggressive or profane language
- Violent actions, intentions, and or threats.
- Sexually explicit gestures
- Physical and sexual violence
- Brandishing weapons
